

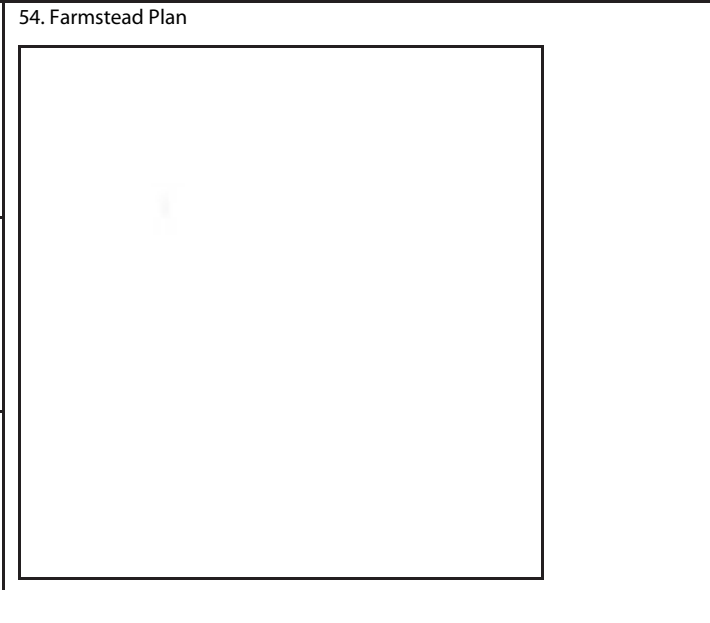

42. Further Description of Important Interior and Exterior Features (Con't)

a metal rail lead up to the door. To the right of the projecting section are two pairs of casement windows. The casement windows have two horizontal muntins in each. The east and west elevations have two pairs of casement windows below simulated half timbering. At the east elevation, the grade of the driveway descends below street level.
