**The Oberlin Heritage Center/O.H.I.O.** received the **Trustees Honor Award for Organizational Achievement in Preservation** from the Cleveland Restoration Society and Preservation Resource Center of Northeastern Ohio at the 2003 Preservation Awards Ceremony/31<sup>st</sup> Annual Membership Meeting of the Cleveland Restoration Society held at the Cleveland Masonic Auditorium on July 24<sup>th</sup>.

Executive Director Pat Murphy and Past President/current Staff Member Pat Holsworth proudly accepted the award on behalf of O.H.I.O.'s board, staff, members and volunteers. The Oberlin Heritage Center/O.H.I.O. was recognized for its excellent programs and tours, for the restoration of its buildings at the Oberlin Heritage Center, and for its work in preserving Oberlin's heritage.
